

ALERT:

YARN RECALL

In keeping with our guarantee, that products sold are free from defect at the time of sale, The Knit With is *voluntarily* recalling the following yarns :

* **Knitting Fever, Inc. disputes the reliability of the facts underlying this recall.**

These yarns are labeled as spun with a cashmere fibre content which they do not, in fact, have – as confirmed by expert fibre analysis.

The Cashmerinos have a 0% cashmere content while the Noro yarns, at best, have only slightly more than half of the labeled cashmere content. All six yarns are either defectively spun, improperly labeled, or both. These yarns should not have been sold by the distributor as labeled.

Knitting Fever, Inc. disputes the necessity of this recall and insists that elaborate testing indicates the Cashmerinos are now spun with cashmere; the improper cashmere content of the Noro yarns has never been addressed by Knitting Fever, Inc.

The Knit With would never knowingly sell defective yarns – whether the defect is because of improper labeling or otherwise. We respect and value, too much, our customers' goodwill. We regret our error in relying – alone, but in good faith – upon the distributor's multiple representations, over many years, concerning the fibre content and premium quality of these defective and improperly labeled yarns.

The Knit With deeply apologizes for this situation. We stand up to our guarantee that all products purchased from this shop are free of defect at the time of purchase.

Patrons of The Knit With who have purchased any quantity of these yarns, at any time, are eligible to participate in this recall; participants will receive a store credit for the full, net purchase price they paid plus 10%. Other benefits apply as well.

Completion of a Consumer Claim Form and submission of proof of purchase are required. A shop receipt indicating purchase of a recalled yarn and ballband labels constitutes the best proof of purchase. Identity verification may be requested to prove purchase based upon ballband labels or knitting alone; other terms and conditions apply where proof of purchase must be constructed in the absence of a shop receipt and ballband labels.
